Minutes of April 14, 2026

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District #47 was called to order by Commissioner Bruce at 7:01pm. Commissioner Bruce made a motion to approve the previous months minutes. Commissioner Beniasch seconded the motion.

Secretary Report: Still need to go to a few banks to find out if we can get a better credit limit on our credit cards. Budget has been entered into Springbrook. Need to contact Springbrook to do GL entries to back out January and February to add to correct categories. Working on Q1 payroll tax returns. State Audit is due end of May, will start that soon.

Financial Report: Balance of funds on April 14th, 2026

Expense Fund: \$395,566.58-\$27,056.59 (March Expense Vouchers)=\$**368,509.99**

GO Bond Fund: \$1,313.40

Vouchers: The March Expense fund vouchers were reviewed. Commissioner Bruce made a motion to approve payment of vouchers. Commissioner Beniasch seconded the motion, and the March Expense fund vouchers were signed for \$27,056.59. The Acrisure NW check is over \$8k. Discussion about this.

- Sent new policies (SOP/SOG revisions) to Commissioners for approval. Commissioner Bruce made a motion to approve these, Commissioner Beniasch seconded the motion.

- Inventory of Bunker gear shows we need some new items, may go over budget. Oxygen Bottle lift received.
- Fire Alarm was fixed in bay. Electrician from Black Diamond came out.
- Bay door needs to be fixed.
- Documents are complete for air trailer.

- Hose Testing is set up for April 22nd, joint with Enumclaw.
- Possible new generator for Station 89

Unfinished Business:

1. Levy Lift- Shannon created the Resolution, same as last time, just changed some of the dates. Went over the Explanatory Statement, Shannon will send two versions for Commissioner approval, then send Resolution and Statement to Snure for review. Due to King County Elections by May 1st. Commissioner Beniasch made a motion to approve the Resolution, Commissioner Bruce seconded the motion.
2. New apparatus to replace T89. New apparatus was found. Shannon still needs to send financial information to Kim. Sent an email last week to verify info was correct. Shannon will send all the missing financial information to Kim tomorrow morning. Commissioner Bruce will contact Kim from PNC for more follow up.
3. State retirement-Shannon sent in the resolution. There has been some emails back and forth but need some clarification. I'll reach out again and should have an update by next month.

New Business: Shannon sent an email to Chief earlier today regarding a voicemail from someone regarding the bike race this weekend in town. Shannon will forward to Howard and Jay since Chief is out of town so that they can follow up.
