Minutes of August 11th, 2026

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District #47 was called to order by Commissioner Freitag at 7:06pm.

Commissioner Beniasch made a motion to approve the previous months minutes. Commissioner Freitag seconded the motion.

Financial Report: Balance of funds on August 11th, 2026

Expense Fund: \$433,746.83-\$14,352.28 (July Expense Vouchers)=\$419,394.55

GO Bond Fund: \$1,327.09

Vouchers: The July Expense fund vouchers were reviewed. Commissioner Freitag made a motion to approve payment of vouchers. Commissioner Beniasch seconded the motion, and the July Expense fund vouchers were signed for \$14,352.28.

Chief's Report:

- Waiting on the approved policies (SOP/SOG revisions). Chairperson signed.
- Volunteer Stipend Policy is complete, but Snure is reviewing.
- The county issued a full environmental impact statement for the Segale project
- Maintenance on trucks has started. E89 oil leak, easy fix, but half of lighting not working

- 2 people starting EMT School
- Bunker gear has been ordered

Unfinished Business:

1. Levy Lift-Right the results will not be certified until August 18th, 2026. But as of 4pm today it's 53.10% rejected. Someone reached out to Commissioner Beniasch watching our elections and can help in the future to help us pass a levy lift with some new ideas. Discussion on how/if we can get a list of registered voters from the district. Shannon will reach out to Snure about questions that were asked about current Levy Lift.
2. New apparatus to replace T89. Wait until the September meeting to discuss after the elections have been certified.
3. Two Signage quotes sent over by Alex. Commissioner Beniasch hasn't received anything further from Alex but will follow up.

New Business:

1. Estimate/Bid for pressure washing, roof washing, and gutter cleaning received from Howard. Commissioner Beniasch made a motion to approve the estimate/bid. Commissioner Freitag seconded the motion.
